Moral of the story: Slow and steady win the race.

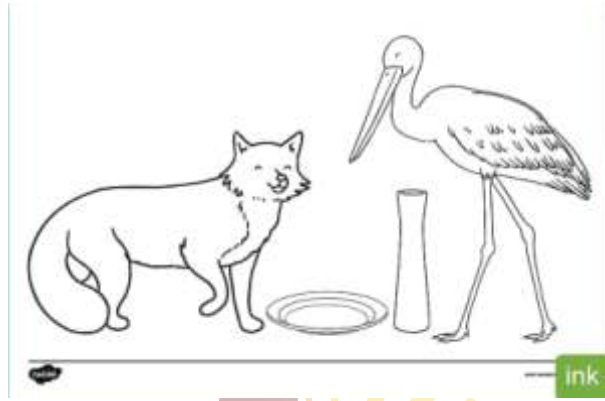
STORY : THE CAP SELLER AND THE MONKEY
